Homily Snippets

When we encounter Christ on our own, everything changes. The Lord often uses other people in our lives to invite us to take the next step where we can encounter Jesus. Everyone has an innate desire for God, but we often look for the Lord in the wrong places.

The Magi had a desire to search for God. King Herod also wanted to find Christ. Herod felt threatened and reacted out of fear, while the Magi were drawn to the Christ child by a star or an angel. When they found Him, they prostrated themselves in worship, before returning home, changed.

We can all be stars or messengers; the sign that points others to Christ so that they can encounter Him for themselves. We are all expected to evangelize. Invite others to Mass, to Adoration, to a small group or a Bible study. Share a book or a podcast or a video that spoke to you. Maybe you are the star that points them to Jesus. Evangelization is about relationships. Who is the Lord calling you to invite?
